Enjoy a living history adventure experiencing life during the Revolutionary War period—mock battles, candle making, caramel apple dipping (you get to keep the apple), cider pressing (no drinking the cider), etc. will entertain you. This tour is sure to please folks of all ages: kids and grandkids are welcome--we encourage you to bring them.

A colonial-style lunch will be served at 1:00 p.m. consisting of: chicken pot pie (vegetable pot pie for those who prefer), green salad with buttermilk ranch dressing, corn chowder, Sally Lunn bread (an authentic bread for the period), and apple crisp. Beverages include a choice of lemonade, iced tea, or coffee.

The cost of the guided tour, including lunch, is \$30.00 for adults, and \$20.00 for children 12 and under.

This is a walking tour on unpaved terrain--wear casual clothes and comfortable shoes.

Following lunch, you are on your own to explore the many other areas of interest at Riley's

Farm. You may also retrace by car the Oak Glen Road and visit the various specialty shops along the way. To visit the famous antique district in Beaumont, follow Oak Glen Road south to Ramsey. Turn left on Ramsey and you will immediately see the shops.
