

Shoehorn Museum & Jay's Garage – West Covina, CA

Sunday, April 21, 2013

We have a very special tour planned; interesting museums and a fabulous bar-B-que at Jay's Garage. Our Region is heading to West Covina for a special tour of the private Shoehorn Museum and the West Covina Historical Society museum. This truly unique museum has hundreds (thousands?) of shoehorns and other historical items collected by Dr Forest Tennant from around the world. It is truly a one-of-a-kind, likely the largest in the world and is not open to the public; we are the guests of Dr. Tennant, who is also a Packard collector. The collection includes centuries old bone, silver and other metal shoehorns and many 19th & 20th century examples displaying advertising (including Packard). We also plan to visit the nearby West Covina Historical Museum that contains many displays and artifacts of the West Covina & the San Gabriel Valley.

Our next stop will be Jay's Garage in the City of Industry. Jay (I'm your tour master, not that late night TV host – sorry) & Dee have a "working shop" with Packards, Dodges, a Crosley and an old Drag race gasser as well as lots of collectable automobilia. We will have lunch prepared by Jimmy the "HATT" Nunez, a well know local BBQ wizard (remember him last year at the Communications Museum in April??). Food is important to Pler, so we plan to have fresh BBQ hamburgers & hot dogs grilled on site, together with side dishes. And, maybe even a homemade desert by Dee! No one leaves hungry.

We will meet at the Museum at 10:30 to 11:30 am for coffee & donuts. After touring both museums, we will caravan a few miles to Jay's garage in the City of Industry. Lunch served from about 12:30 to 2:00. As we prepare for and eat lunch, there will be plenty of time to visit with your old PI friend and make new ones and check out Jay & Dee's collections.
