

2013 Huntington Beach Concours d'Elegance

Sunday, June 2, 2013

This is the 27th year for the Huntington Beach Concours and it continues to be an outstanding automotive event in the Southern California car culture. Last year, a field of 14 Packards was the highlight of the show, and Bill Maya's beautiful 1956 Caribbean Convertible took home best of show honors. The Concours is held on the grounds of the Huntington Beach Central Park, adjacent to the Huntington Beach Central Library and Cultural Resource Center at Talbot and Golden West. The show is held annually to support the Children's Resource Center of the Library.

Again this year, Bart McGrath, founder of the Huntington Beach Concours, has invited the Southern California Region of Packards International to participate in the event and has reserved prime space in the center of the show for 20 Packards to be grouped together.

Also, to encourage participation by our club in this year's event, our members are being offered a special Packard VIP package discount that includes A VIP Luncheon for two along with your entry. The Packard VIP Package includes entry for your Automobile in the event (\$35.00) and two VIP Luncheon Tickets, (normally cost \$25.00 each) for a total of \$60.00. This package is being offered only to Piers and represents a \$25 discount. The VIP Luncheon allows entrance to the VIP tent and provides an amiable place for our members to lunch and lounge together in small groups. We assume each of our members will want to take advantage of the VIP Luncheon, however, there will be other food vendors at the show. The Automobile only entry fee is \$35.00.

The Concours d'Elegance is our June 2013 event and we want to have a strong showing of Packards. Mr. McGrath has provided special Packard classes for judging. You do not need to have your car judged, but we encourage you to do so.

The Huntington Beach Concours is Sunday, June 2, 2013, from 9:00AM to 4:00PM. Entrants should plan on parking by 8:00AM.

From North - Take 405 South to Exit #16 – Beach Blvd.; left onto Center Ave. for about 500 ft., then right onto Beach Blvd. Take Beach Blvd. about 2.1 miles to Talbert Ave. Right on Talbert, proceed about 1 mile; Talbert ends at the library parking lot.

From South – Take 405 North to Exit # 15 - Magnolia St./Warner Avenue West. Stay in right lane of off-ramp to Warner Avenue West. Proceed on Warner for about 1.7 miles to Beach Blvd. Turn Left on Beach Blvd, proceed for about 1.1 miles to Talbert Ave. Right on Talbert, proceed about 1 mile; Talbert ends at the library parking lot.

RULES OF ENTRY

The Committee reserves the right to accept or deny entry. Entrants will be notified of acceptance or denial.

1. The Committee reserves the right to combine or divide classes depending on the number of entries accepted. If the number received warrants, classes will be further split.
2. The Committee will have the final decision on classification.
3. All cars should be pre-registered by Tuesday, May 27, 2013, and the "Release of Liability" must be signed.
4. No "Entry-Day" entries are accepted for judging. Payment must accompany registration.
5. All cars must be placed by 8:00 am.
6. All cars must remain in position on the field until 4:00 P.M.
7. No "For Sale" signs, displays, stanchions, canopies, EZups, detail, or support vehicles allowed.
8. A club or automobile marquée may wish to sponsor its own classes. For example, the NCCC has specific class for Corvettes and we accommodate them.
9. Entry fees are non-refundable.
10. Except for the Featured Marqués, all cars and motorcycles manufactured within the last five years of the current year's event will be placed in our "special interest" class on chief judge's determination based on total entries received by May 24, 2013.
11. City Ordinance prohibits alcoholic beverages in the park.
